## C. External User Recertification System – Identified Official with Authority (IOwA)

M/S Haug/Kimpton to authorize Callie Jacobs to act as the Identified Official with Authority (IOwA) for the Saint Paul Conservatory for Performing Artists (#4112). Motion passed unanimously.

The Minnesota Department of Education (MDE), Professional Educator Licensing Standards Board (PELSB), and Office of Higher Education (OHE) require annual designation of an Identified Official with Authority (IOwA) for each local education agency that uses the Education Identity Access Management (EDIAM) system. The IOwA is responsible for authorizing, reviewing, and recertifying user access for their local education agency in accordance with the State of Minnesota Enterprise Identity and Access Management Standard, which states that all user access rights to Minnesota state systems must be reviewed and recertified at least annually. The Identified Official with Authority will authorize user access to State of Minnesota Education secure systems in accordance with the user's assigned job duties and will revoke that user's access when it is no longer needed to perform their job duties.

### X. Reports & Discussion

## A. 2022-2023 Enrollment Summary

Superintendent Jacobs presented the 2022-2023 Enrollment Summary. There are currently 402 students enrolled. Enrollment is lower than the past few years. The number may grow once we hit the quarter mark. However, if enrollment continues to remain at current levels or decline, the budget will be revised.

### B. 2022 June Preliminary Financial Statements

Superintendent Jacobs shared the 2022 June Preliminary Financial Statements in anticipation of the upcoming audit for FY22.

## C. Administrative Reports

Principal Goranson shared that it has been challenging to get applications for instructors. Goranson wants to think of ways to start recruiting instructors in nontraditional ways.

Goranson expressed gratitude to the Ordway for providing their space for free to have SPCPA's first ever all school assembly. It was important to ground ourselves in the mission and vision of the school.

Goranson shared that ACT scores dropped last year across the board and PSAT had about a 10% drop in scores in each grade level.
