<p>Provide the established SMART goal for the 2022–23 SY.</p> <p>The percentage of SPCPA students in all subgroups will meet or exceed standards on the MCA in math, reading, and science, respectively at 6% or greater as compared to state and resident district subgroup achievement levels.</p>	<p>Provide the result for the 2022–23 SY that directly ties back to the established goal.</p> <p>63% of Hispanic/Latino students met or exceeded standards on the MCA in <i>reading</i>, exceeding the state mark for Hispanic/Latino students by 35.3% and the St Paul Public Schools mark by 38.9%. 25% of Hispanic/Latino students met or exceeded standards on the MCA in <i>math</i>, exceeding the state mark in the subgroup by 8.8% and the St. Paul Public Schools mark by 13.2%. 40% of Hispanic/Latino students met or exceeded standards on the MCA in <i>science</i>, exceeding the state mark by 20.1% and exceeding the mark for the same subgroup in St. Paul Public Schools by 31%. SPCPA did not reach the threshold for reporting data (10 students) in any other nonwhite demographic category to report on any other subgroups for math, reading, or science.
