# World's Best Workforce

## **Goals and Results**

#### Close the Achievement Gap(s) Between Student Groups

The percentage of SPCPA students in all subgroups will meet or exceed standards on the MCA in math, reading, and science, respectively at 6% or greater as compared to state and resident district subgroup achievement levels. Provide the result for the 2022–23 SY that directly ties back to the established goal.

63% of Hispanic/Latino students met or exceeded standards on the MCA in *reading*, exceeding the state mark for Hispanic/Latino students by 35.3% and the St Paul Public Schools mark by 38.9%. 25% of Hispanic/Latino students met or exceeded standards on the MCA in *math*, exceeding the state mark in the subgroup by 8.8% and the St. Paul Public Schools mark by 13.2%. 40% of Hispanic/Latino students met or exceeded standards on the MCA in *science*, exceeding the state mark by 20.1% and exceeding the mark for the same subgroup in St. Paul Public Schools by 31%. SPCPA did not reach the threshold for reporting data (10 students) in any other nonwhite demographic category to report on any other subgroups for math, reading, or science. Opt-out rates have increased by 90% since Distance Learning and the COVID-19 pandemic.

<u>Math</u>: 38 students (35%) opted out. 69 total students took the test (out of which 12 did not finish - those partially completed tests do count toward the school's overall score.)

#### Reading:

12 students (13%) opted out. 90 total students took the test (2 did not finish).

<u>Science</u>: 15 students (19%) opted out. 80 total students took the test (1 did not finish).
